Message From Membership

Dear Members,

How quickly the years go. We have to remember to live life to the fullest and try to make a difference in the lives of others. With well over 700 members, you are all doing your part by supporting The Pap Corps and our Bellaggio Chapter. Remember, each dollar raised goes towards new treatments and continued research for ALL cancers.

Annual and lifetime dues remain at \$50 and \$350 respectively. Effective January 1, 2027, the fee for lifetime membership will increase to \$400. Take advantage of our current rate and become a lifetime member for only \$350 before December 31, 2026.

The Pap Corps has made some additional changes to their membership procedures:

1. Annual upgrades to life membership MUST be paid within 30 days of the date of your check for annual dues. After the 30 days, your \$50 payment will not be credited to your lifetime membership and it will then be \$350 or \$400 depending on whether it is 2026 or 2027.
2. A member in good standing for 2026 will be able to attend our annual Membership Luncheon. However, their dues must be paid by **October 15, 2026** in order to attend.

This is a reminder that beginning October 1st, we will be collecting dues for 2027 from existing members and always welcome new members to The Pap Corps. You can mail or drop off your check at the home of either Jeanne Rosenstein, Margie Ginsberg or Maria Schaeffer or at the ticket fairs. Each of us has a Pap box by our front doors.

The membership year is from January 1st through December 31st.

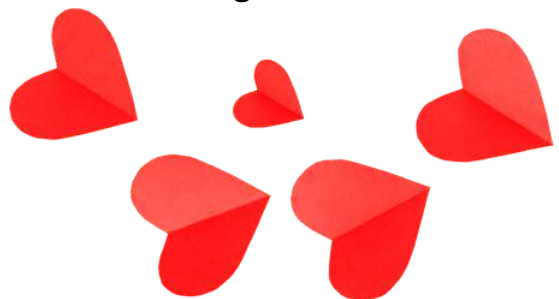
Pap Caring and Sharing

Perseverance and Progress in Pancreatic Cancer Care

Pancreatic cancer survivor Paul Flamm has nothing but praise and admiration for Peter Hosein, M.D., a renowned medical oncologist at Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center, part of the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. "From the very beginning, he told me, 'We're going to treat this. It's not going to be easy, but we'll get through it,'" said Flamm, who is now in remission. "... He's given me at least two years, and I don't know how many more. His dedication to his research and his patients is unmatched."

Sylvester consistently delivers extraordinary outcomes, especially for patients with hard-to-treat cancers such as pancreatic cancer, which has a five-year survival rate of only 13%. Sylvester patients experience survival rates up to 14% higher than the national average for early-and late-stage pancreatic cancer. This success is driven in large part by the Sylvester Pancreatic Cancer Research Institute (SPCRI) which integrates outstanding clinical care with world-class research to discover, develop and deliver personalized treatment strategies to pancreatic cancer patients.

Sylvester's Director Stephen D. Nimer, M.D., adds, "We established the SPCRI to bring together the most talented minds in the field and equip them with the tools needed to advance science and develop novel treatments that can save more lives."

Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center Opens

New Trial for Neuroendocrine

A clinical trial for patients with high-grade neuroendocrine tumors is now open for enrollment at the Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center. The new trial, headed by Aman Chauhan, M.D., leader of the Neuroendocrine Tumor Program at Sylvester, offers a fresh approach. Patients will receive a combination of immunotherapy drugs and a tumor-busting "oncolytic" virus injected directly into the tumors.

Tumors in any organ, at any age

High-grade neuroendocrine cancer is a complex and aggressive condition that has seen few medical advances, in part because its rare. Neuroendocrine tumors originate from cells found throughout the body and can affect most organ systems. They most often attack the lungs, gastrointestinal tract, gynecological tract and prostate. Victims of high-grade disease include Sean Stone, an emerging Hollywood producer who passed away last March at only 26 years of age, and Nichole Borchard, a vibrant mother of two young children who died in September 2024 at age 39.

In the new trial, Dr. Chauhan will combine immunotherapy drugs called checkpoint inhibitors with an oncolytic virus that has been tested for safety in previous trials. Checkpoint inhibitors have broadened treatment options for a growing list of tumor types, from melanoma to lung cancer. The challenge is to increase the number of patients who fully respond to immunotherapy.. The oncolytic virus, SVV, doesn't infect normal cells. It grows inside tumor cells and busts them open. When the tumor cells burst, they release their contents, activating the immune system. The new phase 1 trial will enroll about 36 people whose tumors have become resistant to or failed previous lines of therapy. In the past two years, more than 550 new patients from 30 different states and 10 different countries have come to Sylvester for treatment and access to neuroendocrine cancer clinical trials.

Another example of what our support for Pap research is accomplishing.

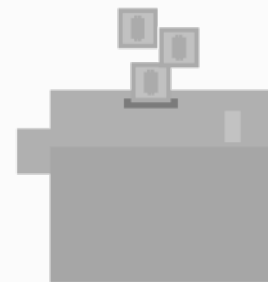
