# SARCOMA PEER MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

SUPPORTING NEWLY DIAGNOSED PATIENTS

Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center created the Sarcoma Mentorship Program for newly diagnosed patients to receive support during their journey. By becoming a mentor you'll be matched with a recently diagnosed patient to provide ongoing support as they navigate treatment. Once matched, mentors will offer support via phone, text, email, and/or video conferencing as agreed upon with the patient.

### Interested in becoming a mentor through Sylvester?

Mentors must:

- Be at least one-year post active treatment (not including maintenance therapy).
- Have received treatment at Sylvester.
- Undergo an interview, complete a questionnaire that will be used to make matches, and receive extensive training via video conferencing.

Applying to become a mentor does not guarantee you will receive an assignment.  
This is a voluntary role.
