Where Do Our Pap Dollars Go?



During this most difficult year, the chapters of The Pap Corps were able to present a check for two million dollars to Dr. Stephen Nimer, Director of the Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center. **Where do our dollars go?** Sylvester's more than 300 cancer-focused doctors and researchers are turning today's scientific discoveries into tomorrow's treatments. Research is divided into three areas- **Cancer Control, Cancer Epigenetics, and Tumor Biology.**

Cancer Control

Our own Dr. Erin Kobetz and Dr. Frank Penedo bring together multiple University of Miami departments to assess local cancer statistics and develop support for our community. The **Cancer Survivorship Research Program** takes a multidisciplinary approach with over 30 faculty members assessing and managing symptoms and toxicities, and behavioral interventions to promote quality of life, and manage stress, and symptoms. The Pap Corps is partnering with Sylvester and is developing a **Survivorship Mentor Program** as a new benefit to Pap members. Pap Corps Members who are 1 year cancer survivors are trained by Sylvester to become **Survivorship Mentors**. Mentors will offer supportive oncology services to Pap members and their loved ones- including physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs before, during, and after cancer treatment.

Cancer Epigenetics

Researchers are studying the factors in molecules that cause mutations. The goal is to develop new medicines and identify markers in the blood that are early signs of cancer. Sylvester has a team of doctors to mentor post-doctoral fellows who will focus on blood malignancies, cancer genetics, drug discovery and bioinformatics. To assist with this research, Dr. Nimer announced the purchase a special microscope at a cost of \$500,000 that sees into individual molecules to understand the factors that initiate and sustain cell mutations.

Tumor Biology

Cancer research now is moving from looking at individual genes towards understanding how interactions between cells and cell systems give rise to tumors. This program focuses on (1) The causes of tumor initiation and progression; (2) The influence of inflammation and immunity on tumor development; and (3) The measures needed to bridge the gap from therapeutics discovered in the test tubes of the Sylvester labs to therapies that become part of pre-clinical and clinical studies.

Dr. Nimer announced a **new cancer research building** on the campus of Sylvester. It will have **90 new labs** and he is in the process of hiring **630 new researchers**. He has already hired three new breast cancer surgeons and one pancreatic cancer surgeon- all happen to be women. But Dr. Nimer also emphasized it's not about the individual, but about the team. To that end, NCI designated cancer centers are the crown jewels in our nation's effort to fight cancer.
