Walkathon for cancer research

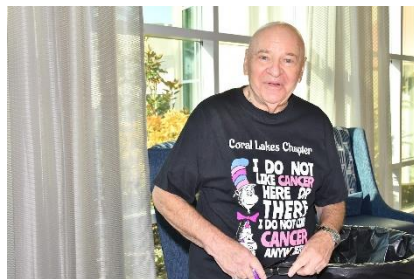
