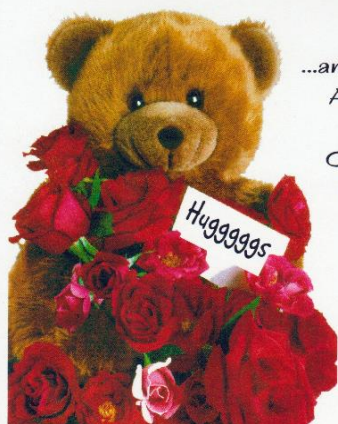

# MY ROUTINE PHYSICAL WAS NOT SO ROUTINE

I had gone for my regular checkup. When the doctor looked at the lab results of my bloodwork, his brow creased. Silently I said to myself: “uh-oh”. It seems that my white count was extremely high for the second time in a row. He felt that it might be Leukemia (double “uh-oh”), and made an appointment for me with an oncological hematologist at Boca Regional. I was in shock. I got ready to go immediately, however, the earliest appointment available was 3 weeks. I tried and tried but the calendar just wouldn’t move faster. Of course I only told my husband, daughter and son. No need to worry my friends and grandchildren. The day finally came, and with my daughter in tow (so I didn’t miss a word), went to my date with destiny.

The hematologist said that she needed extensive blood tests that would take at least two weeks to be analyzed and read. There was nothing else to do but give blood and wait again. During the waiting period I began to think about whether I wanted a long or short wig? How long did I have? Should I start to give my husband his instructions on how to survive without me? I did tell my best friend what was happening and in Huntington Lakes, the news spreads like wild fire.

The day of the appointment blossomed, grey and dreary, a sure sign from above.

Once again I dragged my daughter to the doctors office and sat down fully unprepared for what she was going to tell me. I had expected, by now, to have had a heart attack from nerves. The doctor started by telling me that there is no sign of Leukemia or any other disease that is causing my white count to soar. The condition is called Monoclonal B-cell lymphocytosis. Basically it is a defective gene and there is nothing to worry about. There is no treatment or meds for it. It is not a disease but a condition.

Needless to say, I am extremely relieved, but my nerves may never recover.

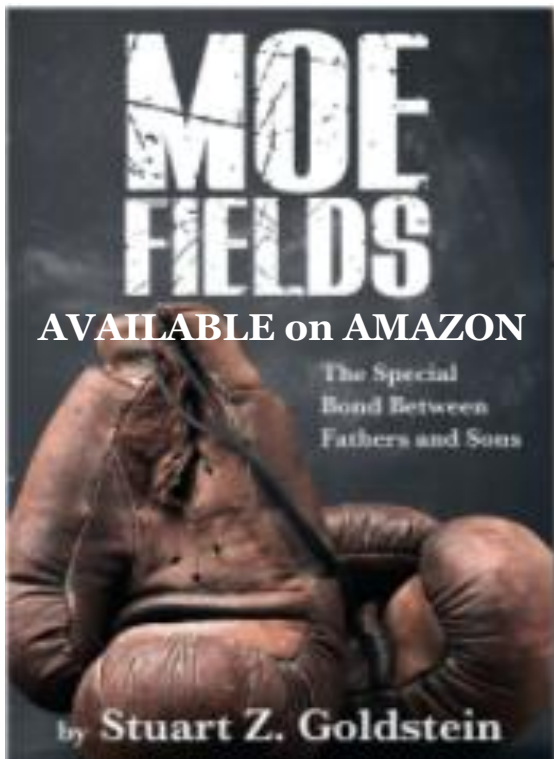

Moe Fields is a gripping narrative about a father's fighting spirit and determination to save his family and inspire his sons to succeed. Goldstein applies his gift of storytelling to bring us the story of Moe Fields growing up during the Great Depression—from his teens as a Golden Glove boxer, to his career as a bootleg fighter in Brooklyn for money, to being a WWII sailor whose most prideful moment was meeting FDR, to overcoming prejudice and building one of the largest plumbing businesses in New Jersey.
